




#### Results of the Danube Regional Project I.



- Development of methodologies for stress and impact analisys
- Development of the typology of surface waters and definition of relevant reference conditions
- Implementation of the ecological assessment in line with EU WFD using specific bio-indicators
- Application of the EU Guidelines for economic analisys and arrive at a comparative overall economic analisys for the Danube River Basin





#### Results of the Danube Regional Project II.

- Development of RBM tools and related data management
- Characterization and analisys of transboundary groundwater bodies
- Organization of workshops and training courses in order to produce the River Basin Management Plan and to strenghten basin-wide cooperation
