



Introduction

The Alpine Network brings together all large protected areas (over 100 hectares) with field methods and activities that are compatible with the Alpine Convention. It is a network of protected areas that work together to promote contacts between the Alpine public, active researchers, biologists, managers, quiet users and other kinds of protected areas, and to support the implementation of the Alpine Convention by involving local stakeholders, local residents and scientific experts.

The objectives

The aim of the Alpine Network of Protected Areas is to pool expertise, techniques, and methods used by the managers of Alpine protected areas to:

- Conservation and management of the Alpine protected areas and their natural resources, habitats and biodiversity species, while complying with the international agreements and guidelines in force, particularly the presence for minimum standards of protection of the Alpine Convention.
- Developing tourism that is adapted to mountain life and local heritage conservation and the regional economic programme,
- Supporting mountain agriculture and forestry whilst at the same time maintaining biodiversity,
- Raising awareness, informing and educating the general public and the local population about the natural and cultural values of Alpine protected areas.

In order to encourage cooperation on developing communication tools, on European projects (INTERRA, LIFE...), and on education and cooperation tools for the Alpine protected areas.

The Alpine Network and the Alpine Convention

The Alpine Network of Protected Areas is a tool of the [Alpine Convention](#).

The activities of the Alpine Network are firmly anchored in the Alpine Convention and the accompanying implementing guidelines. The Alpine Convention is a political instrument of the Alpine Convention, which is made up of representatives of protected areas in all the Alpine countries, and approved by the General Assembly. The Alpine Network works closely with the Alpine Convention and its Alpine Convention Unit, in order to implement the Alpine Convention and its accompanying guidelines.
